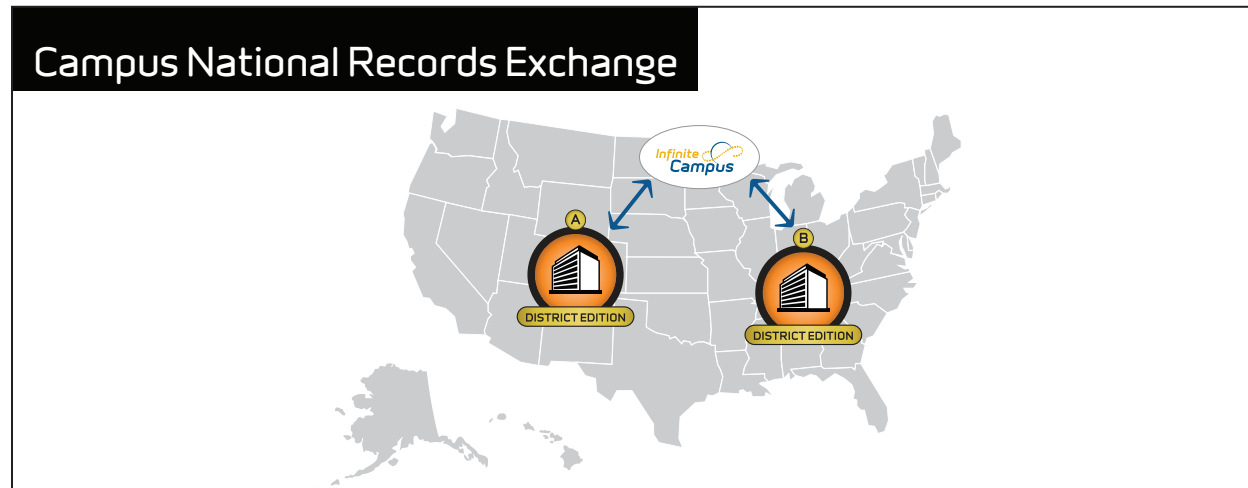


Nationwide District-to-District Data Transfers

The Campus National Records Exchange is a standardized records transfer utility that will work between two Infinite Campus districts regardless of physical location. When a district activates this functionality and “joins” the Infinite Campus national community of users, districts can request detailed student data from the original district and reduce manual data entry.



The ability to leverage student data transfer on a national level is a unique benefit provided to Infinite Campus customers.

Data Available for Transfer

Student data available via the import wizard includes:

- Transcripts
- Enrollment history
- Assessments
- Immunizations
- Health conditions and screening

Student data available via read-only pdf:

- Transcripts
- Census contact summary
- Enrollment history
- Schedules
- Attendance period details
- Assessment summaries
- Behavior summaries
- Health condition summaries
- Health screening summaries
- Immunization summaries
- Report cards
- IEP
- Special education evaluation

How It Works

1. Provided only to Infinite Campus customers
2. Participation by district customers is voluntary
3. A registry of participating districts is managed by Infinite Campus
4. Receiving district requests the student’s records
5. Sending district approves the request
6. The approved request and student data is messaged through the National Campus Router to the receiving district. Infinite Campus only routes data - no data is stored.
7. Receiving district is notified of the approval
8. Receiving district can view and import the student data sent from the sending district
